INSTRUCTOR BIOGRAPHIES

Terry Smith – Terry Smith is a Fire Investigator for EFI Global working in the state of Iowa and surrounding states. He is an instructor with the College of DuPage in the Fire/Arson Investigation Program. He was previously the Investigation/Prevention Program Director at the Illinois Fire Service Institute, University of Illinois. Terry is an IAAI Certified Fire Investigator. He serves on the NFPA 1033 Committee. Terry received his Bachelor of Arts Degree with a Fire Science emphasis from Western Illinois University.

Jack Nevins – Jack Nevins is a Senior Consultant for Semke Forensic Consulting. He has 20 years of diverse technical experience, including 11 years providing senior level forensic and investigative services to the insurance, legal and corporate communities. Jack has handled cases involving analysis of high-technology and complex losses, electronic evidence, theft of confidential data, equipment failure analysis and fire cause analysis. Jack received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Applied Physics with an Electrical Engineering minor from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. He is a Certified Computer Examiner through the International Society of Forensic Computer Examiners.

Jason Wollum, PE - Jason Wollum is an Electrical Engineer /Associate at Henderson Engineers Inc. in Lenexa Kansas. He is a licensed PE.
