## INSTRUCTOR BIOGRAPHIES

**Dr. Dian Williams** is president and founder of the Center for Arson Research, a criminal profiling company specializing in crimes related to arson. Dr. Williams lectures extensively at home and abroad on the pathology of firesetting, fire bombing, domestic terrorism and violent sex crimes involving burning/firesetting. She appears regularly in the print and visual media and consults with federal, state and local criminal justice and mental health agencies throughout the United States, Canada, Australia, Sweden and the United Kingdom. During the mid-80's, Dian Williams appeared before the U.S. Senate as an expert on juvenile firesetters and violent juvenile offenders.

**Christopher Elrod** is a Captain in the Wilmington Fire Department Fire Marshal's Office. Captain Elrod has worked in both the public and private sector as a fire investigator for over 30 years as well as being an instructor for the past 25 years. Captain Elrod is currently on the Board of Directors for the NCIIA as well as serving on the training committee. Captain Elrod has been utilized as a subject matter expert in the investigation of fires involving motor vehicles for both the North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation as well as the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives.

**Kevin Oliver** has worked for the North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation as a fire investigator for fourteen years and is an IAAI-CFI and IAAI-CI. Since December 2004, Kevin has served as an ATF-certified Accelerant Detection K-9 Handler with K-9s "Jada" and "Dublin". Agent Oliver is currently assigned as a Criminal Specialist/ Program Coordinator for the SBI's statewide Fire Investigation program. He also sits on a number of boards and consults in fire-related legislative matters on the state level. Agent Oliver routinely teaches for local community colleges and the NCI-AAI. Kevin has also taught at the NFA and FLETC.

**Ed Nordskog** is an arson profiler, arson/bomb investigator, and author of multiple books on arson investigation. He has worked over 2,200 arson cases in his 33 years as an investigator for the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department. He has personally handled over 60 fire death scenes, including accidents, suicides, body dumps, murders, and mass murders, and has conducted case analysis on another 50 fire death cases for other agencies. He is one of the few arson profilers in the world and has presented his case work and instruction in 15 states, and four foreign countries. He is a recognized expert on Fire Death Analysis and Serial Arson Investigations.

**Mark McClish** is a retired Supervisory Deputy United States Marshal. He spent nine years teaching interviewing techniques at Marshals Service Training Academy. During this time, he developed the **Statement Analysis®** techniques to detect deception in a verbal and written statement. Mark retired from the Marshals Service in 2009 and started Advanced Interviewing Concepts. His company provides interviewing skills training and assists investigators in analyzing a suspect's statement. Mark currently gives presentations on his **Statement Analysis®** techniques throughout the United States.
